

## XPS, EPS AND CELLULAR RUBBER INSULATION

Self-declaration that the used XPS (extruded polystyrene), EPS (expanded polystyrene) and foam rubber insulation meet the minimum pollutant requirements in BREEAM NOR's 2016 checklist A20

This form must be filled out and signed by a legally responsible person for the building boards manufacturer, such as a technical director or a managing director. Chemicals to be avoided should not be present in the product in unbound, bound or natural form. Concentrations under the threshold value of 0.1% are accepted. It is assumed that the information in the A20 list is known.
